# Colin Hackett Scholarship SELECTION CRITERIA



The successful applicant must meet all of the following criteria:

- The applicant must be a member in good standing with the zone and at a minimum a level 2 official.
- Must be a resident of the zone for the past season and the current season.
- Must be 18 years of age by December 15th of the season they are applying for the scholarship.
- Must be active official working games in the North Zone at any level.
- Must be attending a post secondary college or university in a recognized program on a full time basis (min. of three classes per semester).
- Must list your volunteer experience you have provided as a mentor/leader on and off the ice.
